The Committee reviewed prior proposal for no cost equipment. Contractor reported sizing incorrect and correctly sized unit was approximately \$40,000 for equipment.

State reviewed prior proposal and were not happy with proposed discharge. Staff continues to work with water consultant on a variety of options.

Mr. Lombardozzi reviewed State testing on each of the current building wells. He also discussed potential of adding a new storage tank. Committee also discussed current work by Town on broader well issues in nearby public facilities and that coordination was appropriate next step.
