Policy 9321 Time, Place and Notification of Meetings: the committee will recommend updating this policy with guidelines for electronic participation by board members and video taping of Regular BOE meetings. The committee will recommend a board clerk be appointed to capture the minutes of committee meetings, and an audio recording of committee meetings will be made available for this purpose. Also, a template for committee meeting minutes will be developed and used for consistency purposes.

Policy 6111 School Calendar: The committee will recommend the following changes - remove the reference to New Milford School Districts calendar and the Regional Calendar (RESC), and change "Graduates will wear graduation robes, the colors to reflect the established School colors." to "Graduates will wear graduation robes of a single color representing school unity."

Policy 9160 Student Representative on the BOE: various sample policies were reviewed and discussed. The committee plans to develop a rough draft and discuss at a future meeting.
