2. DISCUSSED:

Mr. Vogt began the meeting by stating the charge of the newly formed Capital Planning Committee as:

To explore more effective means of communication and community outreach specifically in relation Capital improvements. To further investigate options for project concepts should support be deemed inadequate. Engaging local and state stake-holders about project parameters, reimbursement and funding. And to bring those discoveries and options to the board for further action where necessary.

Mr. Vogt asked Dr. Melendez to request a meeting with Tecton Architects to determine what it would take to re-engage them for future planning of the school renovation project.

The committee discussed a draft letter to the selectman which it would recommend to the Board to be sent in response to the feedback provided on the school renovation project at the last BOS meeting. Mr. Vogt suggested that we request a retreat style meeting to discuss the project with the Board of Selectmen.
